Be organized and on time.

Show enthusiasm.

Teach your players the laws of the game.

Be sporting in victory and defeat.

You are responsible for the sportsmanship of your players. If one of your players is disrespectful, irresponsible or overly aggressive, take the player out of the game at least long enough for him/her to calm down.

You are responsible for parent behavior and the conduct of any spectators on the sideline during game play as well. It is imperative to explain acceptable player and parent behavior to your team.
